This has been a very successful year at Granard Middle School. Our teachers and staff worked diligently to provide a nurturing and academically challenging environment. We had 17 Junior Scholars this year. Our Battle of the Brains Team was in the semi-finals; a first for Cherokee County! Our school received a \$20,000 technology grant which was used to purchase IPAD computers for our students. Our students participated in Regional and State Band, as well as having successful seasons in football, volleyball, and basketball. Our School Report Card scores improved and Granard Middle School received the Palmetto Silver Award from the South Carolina Department of Education! Students and staff participated in Writing Across the Curriculum. This was a tremendous success. We continued to stress technology implementation in the classrooms and held school-based training sessions. Additionally, our staff participated in a variety of meaningful professional development opportunities in order to improve classroom performance. Granard became the first middle school in Cherokee County to implement the Positive Behavioral Intervention and Supports (PBIS).
