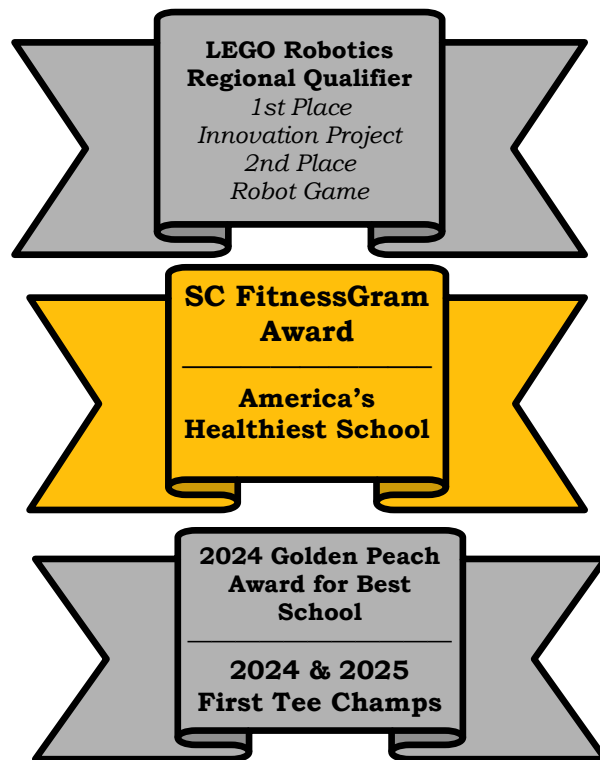


Mission Statement
