
Mission Statement

Strategies for improvement during the 2023-2024 school year are:

- Professional development opportunities will focus on literacy, with an emphasis on Fountas and Pinnell classrooms, AVID, and technology.
- Data analysis will aid teachers with helping to determine student growth and learning goals for class instruction.
- Title I funding will be used for intervention and academic assistance.
- Students experiencing any academic difficulties will participate in the MTSS program to help strengthen those academic skills.
- Parenting sessions will be held during the school year.
- School personnel, parents, and community agencies will work together in an effort to promote educational success for students.
