## Opportunities for Students

**Character Education** (Good Citizens)  
Students from each homeroom are recognized for positively modeling the character word for each month.

**Honor Roll** Each nine weeks, students are recognized for their academic achievement by receiving ribbons and treats for All A and A/B honor roll.

**Attributes of Premier:** Teachers mail 4 postcards per month to students and parents who exhibit the attribute for each month with an explanation as to why the student is chosen.

**Family Fun Nights** Parents and students are invited to participate in two Family Fun Nights. Teachers and community partners provide hands-on activities to promote literacy, math, and science.

**Book Fair** Our Media Center has two Scholastic Book Fairs per year; in the Fall and the Spring. These help to provide new resources for the library and funding for the Summer reading program.

**Field Trips** Students in grades 5K-5th grade enjoy a variety of field trips throughout the year some of which include visiting a local strawberry patch, the Augusta Canal, Bridgestone Industries, Ruth Patrick Science Education Center, and Phinzy Swamp.

**Safety Patrols** Students in 5th grade are selected to serve as the school safety patrols. They assist in many areas of the school such as morning car line, hall monitors, bathroom monitors, bus arrival/dismissal monitors, and flag team.
