## Opportunities for Students

<u>Character</u> <u>Education</u> (Good Citizens) Students from each homeroom are recognized for positively modeling the character word for each month.

**Honor Roll** Each nine weeks, students are recognized for their academic achievement by receiving ribbons and treats for All A and A/B honor roll.

<u>Most Improved Students</u> Each nine weeks, students are recognized for having improved in either grades or behavior.

## **Community Partnerships**
