We continued to strengthen problem based learning, and our teachers attended numerous conferences and training sessions to help equip themselves with appropriate instructional strategies for reaching the needs of our diverse adolescent learners. We provided numerous academic opportunities for our students including STEM classes and PLTW (Project Lead The Way) classes and high school credit classes for 8th graders. Also, we offered additional academic assistance to our students by using Title 1 funds to employ a Reading Interventionist, and to host an after-school homework center. In addition to academic accomplishments, we had great success with our fine arts, athletics, and drama with the production of The Lion King.

Based on PBIS, our students are split into groups and are encouraged by their teachers and peers to follow our Chief Character code. Class Dojo is used to assign points based on attendance and behavior to give incentives.
