
Mission Statement

Curriculum and Professional Development

- ◆ Certified staff participated in on-going sessions in order to fully implement district initiatives such as collaborative instructional planning, student engagement, RtI, data analysis and problem-based learning. All initiatives maintained a focus on college and career readiness, and rigor and relevance across all disciplines.
- ♦ Gaffney Middle continued to integrate technology in the classrooms with laptops, i-Pads, LCD projectors, document cameras, and interactive Activ Boards. Staff participated in device training in preparation for the upcoming 2016-2017 district 1:1 initiative.

Dear Parents,

This year we focused on differentiated instruction and student engagement. We provided numerous academic opportunities for our students including STEM classes in grades 6-8, and high school credit courses for 8th graders. We also offered additional academic assistance to our students by using Title I funds to employ Math and Reading Interventionists. Additionally, we used these funds to implement the Academy of Reading program and to host an after-school homework center.

The majority of our professional development opportunities focused on the continued implementation of the SC College and Career Readiness Standards and grade level teachers planned collaboratively in order to meet the needs of all of our students. We enjoyed our third year as a "Winthrop University Partner School," which offered exciting networking and growth opportunities for Gaffney Middle, as well as for potential Winthrop teaching interns.
