Our History

JDLES is located in Aiken County just off I-20, exit 22 in the heart of the Center community. We serve approximately 596 students in pre-kindergarten 4 year old through fifth grade. The school was opened in 1936 with the current facility opening in 1988. In 1975 the school's name was changed J.D. Lever Elementary School to honor longtime principal, Jesse Daniel Lever, who served as the school principal from 1942 until 1975. The original school was housed in a two-story red brick building located on the current campus. In 1988, classes were moved into a new facility on campus. In 1998, an additional wing was added to the current facility.
