Focus for 2015-2016

English EOC- Increased from 36.6 % in 2011 to 55 % in 2014.

Algebra EOC- Declined from 80.9 % in 2011 to 72.7% in 2014.

<u>U.S.History EOC-</u> Scores increased from 34.3 % in 2011 to 42.9 % in 2014.

Biology EOC- Increased from 39.8 % in 2011 to 66.7 % in 2014.

<u>ACT-</u> Average composite core increased from 18.1 in 2011to 18.3 in 2014.

<u>SAT-</u> The composite score on SAT decreased from 1395 in 2013 to 1339 in 2014.
