Curriculum and Instruction

This year the focus at CMS has been 1 to 1 technology being available in every classroom. In addition to 1 to 1 technology, a school broadcasting team has been established to report school news utilizing graphic design and other technology. The 1 to 1 technology has also made the Success Maker program and Study Island readily available to all students with the hopes of increasing student achievement in all areas. A school-wide writing process was instituted by the English department and the Reading Intervention class was instituted.
