SAT, ACT, and Ready to Work Assessment

The ACT Plus Writing helps to prepare third year students for future life success. The data will help students and families better understand academic performance, improve graduation rates, and ultimately build a stronger, better-equipped workforce. Students should have their scores at the end of their junior year, which will increase their possibilities of going to college and applying for scholarships and financial aid.

The National Spanish Honor Society

The National Spanish Honor Society is comprised of students who have achieved and maintained an A average for three semesters of Spanish. After joining the society, students travel to Queen City Ballroom in Charlotte to learn salsa, merengue, and bachata dances. LHS Student Council

Lewisville High School's Student Council includes nine elected officers as well as elected homeroom representatives. The council oversaw existing programs and initiated many new activities this year. Two new programs include the Lewisville Care Closet and a prayer locker. They coordinated numerous assemblies including a very powerful Black History Month program. They carried out a variety of homecoming spirit week activities, making the week a memorable one. Other activities that kept the council busy included collecting Christmas presents for the Angel Tree Program, and holding a Red Cross Blood Drive in March. The officers were members of a student leadership team who met with the administration on a regular basis. The council aided school administration and guidance counselors with many other projects throughout the year as well. Junior and senior officers were also members of the student cabinet, in which they had the opportunity to meet with the superintendent as well and other district officials to hear current events related to the district and voice their concerns as student leaders.

Teacher Cadet

The LHS Teacher Cadet Class is designed to introduce students to the field of education. Cadets gain an appreciation for the teaching profession that will help them to become valuable

community members. Each year, cadets complete a field experiences at our local elementary and middle schools, participate in College Day at Winthrop University, and volunteer at the SC "End the R Word" Rally and our area Special Olympics.

Interact Club

Lions Interact Club is sponsored by the Chester Rotary Club. The Lions Interact fosters community engagement by carrying out service initiatives and providing volunteer opportunities for student members. Our club members work with other high schools in the district to make up the Chester County Youth Advisory Board. This past year, along with support from the Hazel Pittman Center, Interact members researched and presented a proposal to the Chester County Council and Chester City Council to reduce the percentage of store front advertising of alcohol and nicotine products targeted at young adults. Over the summer, Interact sponsored a county wide Tik Tok Challenge to high school students that promoted healthy, drug and alcohol free lifestyles. Club sponsor is Mrs. Wilder.

FBLA

The mission of Future Business Leaders of America is to bring business and education together in a positive working relationship through innovative leadership and career development programs. Currently, we have ten student members. Students attended the FBLA District Leadership Conference at Dorman High School this year and competed in Economics, Introduction to Business Communication, Introduction to Financial Math, and Personal Finance. Two students, Jessica McAulay and Makayla Xiong, qualified for state competition in North Charleston.

JROTC

The LHS JROTC Program enrollment for SY 2019-2020 was 110 cadets, which equates to 29% of the LHS student body. The Cadet Corps met great success when it competed in the JROTC Leadership & Academic Bowl. The Leadership Team advanced to Level II (Semi-finals) of the competition. The Cadet Drill Team was highly successful in Competition Drill this school year. The team placed in all four competitive events in which it competed. Finally, the Lion Battalion re-established its Marksmanship Team. Even though COVID-19 prevented the Marksmanship Team from competing, the team continues to practice and is postured to be very successful once competitive matches are reinstated.

LHS GUIDANCE

The Lewisville High School Class of 2020 held its commencement exercises Saturday, May 30, 2020 at The Gateway Conference Center. Ninety seniors participated in graduation, with a total of \$5.9 million in scholarship offerings and a graduation rate of 90.9%. Three members of the Class of 2020 earned Associate Degrees prior to graduation, taking full advantage of the dual enrollment partnership between Chester County School District and the University of South Carolina-Lancaster campus.

Concert Band

The Lewisville High School Concert Band competed is SCBDA's Concert Performance Assessment at Nation Ford High School. This event involves preparing music to perform in front of a panel of judges for a rating. Students also had to perform a song they had never seen before for another panel of judges.
