JROTC

JROTC Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC) is a premier leadership program for high school students. JROTC's mission is to motivate young people to be better citizens. The LHS JROTC Program enrollment for SY 2022-2023 was 89 cadets, which equates to 22% of the LHS student body. The Cadet Corps met great success when it competed in the JROTC Leadership & Academic Bowl (JLAB). The JROTC Leadership Team and the Academic Team both advanced to Semi-finals of the JLAB competition. More than 3,200 teams representing Army JROTC programs from high schools from across the country and around the world compete in this annual contest.

The JROTC Air Rifle Marksmanship Team has been hard at practice and competed in a fall and spring league this year. The team finished 17th out of over 300 air rifle teams in the 4th ROTC Brigade Air Rifle Championship. The team also set a new Lewisville High School record by scoring 2014 points. We are postured to participate in the 4th ROTC Brigade's Best of the Best Air Rifle Competition which will be held in December 2023.

Two years in a row, the Lion Battalion Archery Team has earned an invitation to the National Archery in the Schools Program (NASP) Eastern National Championship in Louisville, KY. The team placed overall 8th place in last year's JROTC Division competition. This year, the team set a new LHS record by scoring 1531 points. The Archery team also earned bid into the 4th ROTC Brigade Championship Tournament and placed 3rd overall. We are extremely proud of the dedication of the cadets and the support of our parents.

MAP Testing

Over the course of the 2022-2023 school year, teachers received additional MAP training and MAP scores have improved tremendously. Interventionists (Math & Reading) have been working with Tier III students all of whom have made gains on MAP and demonstrated marked improvements.
