SIC Annual Goals

- The percentage of students scoring 70% or better on the End of Course English 2 exam will increase from 65.6% to 80% in 2026/27.
- The percentage of students scoring 70% or better on the End of Course Algebra 1 exam will increase from 50% to 65% in 2026/27.
- The percentage of students scoring 70% or better on the End of Course Biology 1 exam will increase from 50% in 2020/21 to 60% in 2026/27.
- The percentage of students scoring 70% or better on the End of Course US History exam will increase from 37.5% in 2020/21 to 60% in 2026/27.
- Graduation rate will increase from 89.8% in 2021 to 92% in 2026/27.
- The SIC will strive to provide the support needed to improve instruction to reach these goals.
