2014 PASS PERFORMANCE

Third grade Writing increased 16.4% from 54.5% to 70.9%. Third grade Math increased 13%. Fourth grade Writing increased 17.7% from 49.4% to 67.1%. Fourth grade ELA increased 5.8%. Fifth grade Math increased 13.1% from 53.1% to 66.2%. Sixth grade Math increased 5.5%. Seventh grade Math increased 4.1%. Seventh grade Social Studies increased 8.4%. Eighth grade Writing increased 2%.

2015 MAP PERFORMANCE

From Spring 2014 to Spring 2015, school-wide MAP Math Scores increased 6%. From Spring 2014 to Spring 2015, school-wide MAP Reading scores increase 3%.
