### Student Achievement

**Goal:** The percentage of students scoring met and above in mathematics and ELA will increase.

**Strategies:**

- ◆ Continue to analyze MAP, Fountas & Pinnell, and SC READY data to analyze learning gaps and drive instruction.
- ◆ Use resources and instructional materials to incorporate differentiated learning.
- ◆ Improve student and teacher attendance.

### Climate

**Goal:** The percentage of parents participating in parent/teacher activities that support home/school relations as measured by participation data will increase.

**Strategies:**

- ◆ Provide information to parents and community through effective use of the parenting newsletter, website, School Messenger, Remind App, and local media.
- ◆ Continue to hold Open House at beginning of school year.
- ◆ Continue to use school surveys to gather information from parents, students, and teachers.

### Teacher/Administrator Quality

**Strategies:**

- ◆ Use common grade-level planning, Professional Learning Labs, and afterschool professional development to promote curriculum development and evaluate assessments.
