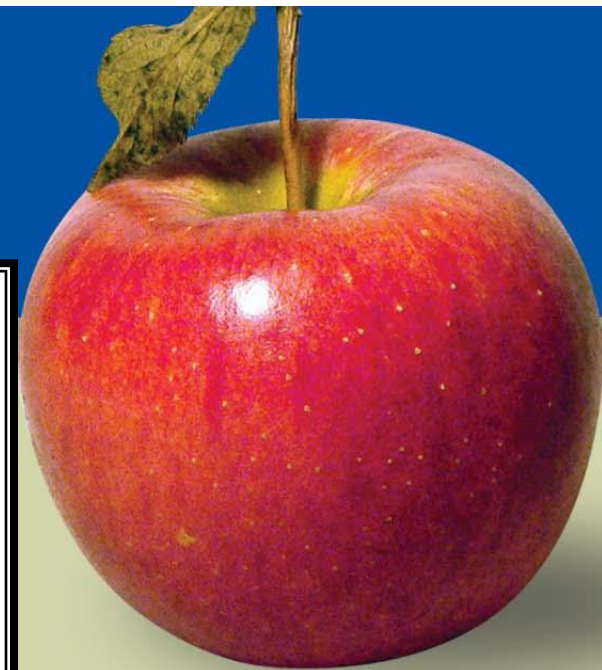

Mission Statement

The mission of Ruby Elementary School is to educate, empower, and inspire our community of young minds.

School Renewal Goals

Goal: The percentage of parents that are satisfied with school-home relations will increase from 64.9% in 2020/2021 to 80% in 2026/2027 as measured by parent responses on state school climate survey.

Strategies:

- Parent Nights
- Quarterly Parent Conferences
- Monthly Newsletters with school events
- Weekly newsletters with classroom activities.



Goal:

The percentage of students in grades 3-5 scoring MET or above on reading as measured by MAP will increase from 23% (third grade), 35% (fourth grade) and 22% (fifth grade) in 2020/2021 to 50% in 2026/2027.

Strategies:

- Teachers will analyze data from various assessments such as common assessment, MAP scores and formative assessments to direct classroom instruction.
- Provide learning opportunities such as professional study groups, teacher observations and coaching conversations
- Literacy Interventionist will identify low achieving students and provide focused literacy instruction.

Goal: The percentage of teachers returning from the previous year will increase from 82.4% in 2020-2021 to 88% in 2026-2027.

Strategies:

- The administrator will provide support in Professional Development to assist teachers with Tier I instruction.
- Provide teachers with effective teaching strategies and support that can be used across the curriculum.
