- The purpose of Title I funds is to support the reading and math programs. These funds were used to hire school interventionists and a regular classroom teacher, implement an after school homework program, and purchase a school site license for the computer math program, Imagine Math.
- Mrs. Laney Rogers, 4th grade ELA teacher, was elected as CIS Teacher of the Year for 2019-2020.
- Mr. Adam Mullins, PE teacher, was recognized as the SC Regular Teacher of the Year by the SC Council for Exceptional Children.
- Mrs. Stephanie Rogers, assistant principal, was recognized as the Educator of the Year by The Wiggins School of Education at Coker College.
- Timmy Witherspoon, 3rd grade student in Mrs. Newton's class, had a perfect score on the SC Ready Math Test.
- The students participated in several service projects for various charitable organizations which included the McArn Food Bank, March of Dimes, Jump Rope for Heart, and Relay for Life.
- Thirty-four outstanding students were inducted into the CIS chapter of the National Elementary Honor Society.
- CIS retained its Arts in Basic Curriculum (ABC) status and thus received grant funds that exceeded \$10,000.
 These funds were used to purchase new instruments, art supplies, and a sound system.
