

Student/School Achievements

The percentage of Chesterfield County students in grades 6-8 scoring MET or above on reading as measured by MAP will increase from 31% (sixth grade), 24% (seventh grade) and 26% (eighth grade) to 55% in 2026/27

The percentage of Chesterfield-Ruby Middle School students in grades 6-8 scoring MET or above on math as measured by MAP will increase from 25% (sixth grade), 20% (seventh grade) and 14% (eighth) to 50% in 2026/27.

The number of 6th grade students at Chesterfield-Ruby Middle school scoring met or above on SCPASS Science will increase from 32.8% in 2021-2022 to 55% in 2026-2027
