Our Art and Music Departments are active and awardwinning in regional, state, and national events. Manning High School continues to offer STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) to our students through "Introduction to Engineering" and "Principles of Engineering."

Manning High School students were introduced to the South Carolina High School Credential Program, which will be aligned to a newly created course of study for students with disabilities whose Individual Education Program (IEP) Team determines this course of study appropriate for them.

Staff began training and implementing PBIS in efforts to celebrate student successes more and reduce disciplinary referrals.
