In April 2019, Manning High School students traveled to London, Dublin, and Paris. This tour provided students with an exciting cultural, language, religious, artistic, scientific, political, historical, and educational experience abroad. Previously, Manning High School students traveled to the Mediterranean Coast in 2018 and the rainforests of Costa Rica in 2017. Our foreign language study and experiences are second to none.

Manning High School continues to advance the Mission of Clarendon School District Two, "Educating Children," by providing an environment where highly qualified teachers engage students in rigorous academic courses of study. During the 2017-2018 year, Manning High had six seniors complete Associate Degree programs and twenty-nine other seniors earned twelve or more college credit hours. The graduating class of 2019 has two seniors who will graduate with their Associate of Arts degree and their high school diploma. The Advance Placement enrollment grew and our students experienced success on AP exams.

Manning High School is committed to transforming teaching and learning by aligning the Workforce 2020 Employer Expectations and career ready characteristics of the Profile of the South Carolina Graduate. Manning High School is home to the number one FFA program, having led the state of South Carolina with the highest enrollment for 27 years. Our AFJROTC unit received an "Exceeds Standards" on their unit inspection and continues to offer a wide range of opportunities for students. Our Athletic Teams remain competitive in all sports, with many sports making at least the first round of playoffs and our boys' basketball team bringing home the region championship.

Our Art and Music Departments are active and award-winning in regional, state, and national events. Manning High School continues to offer STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) to our students through "Introduction to Engineering" and "Principles of Engineering."

Manning High School students were introduced to the South Carolina High School Credential Program, which will be aligned to a newly created course of study for students with disabilities whose Individual Education Program (IEP) Team determines this course of study appropriate for them.

Staff began training and implementing PBIS in efforts to celebrate student successes more and reduce disciplinary referrals.

Manning High School continues to partner with SC State University (TRIO), USC Sumter Upward Bound, and Central Carolina Technical College. Manning High School community partnerships are expanding as we serve host to numerous city and county events throughout the year.
