Our current class of 2015, has the ability to qualify for a 2-year scholarship to Central Carolina To be eligible for the scholarship, students must graduate on time in 2015 with at least a “C” average, and test ready for college level coursework..

TEST PREPARATION

During the 2011-2012 school year, MHS has incorporated MAP testing to assess the needs of our students that are taking HSAP. The students’ test results were used by their teachers to help better prepare them for HSAP testing. Students were offered tutoring 4 days a week after school, as well as a 2-week intensive review prior to the HSAP exam. Throughout the year, we provide special preparedness sessions for SAT, ACT, HSAP, Work Keys, and ASVAB.
