#### Dear Parents,

The reason for this report is to give essential data to partners inside our locale. It is Manning Junior High School's desire to be the best school in South Carolina. The School Improvement Council keeps on playing a functioning and positive role in supporting this idea.

During the 2019-2020 school year, at Manning Junior High School, we have continued some of the same initiatives that have proven to be successful. We have students meeting expectations for the Honor Roll and/or the National Jr. Beta Club. The Original Six Foundation Afterschool Program is in its 4th and is a program where students work hard to improve their classroom learning through the completion on homework assignments and tutoring. The students also participate in an Advisory Period each month where they work on various skills, such as: goal setting and test taking strategies. Students at MJHS had other opportunities to enrich their learning during afterschool hours due to Teacher Office hours. Each teacher provided at least one hour of academic assistance on a weekly basis. During this time students received extra help, tutoring, or made up assignments. The MJHS FFA chapter for 2019-2020 competed in the Conduct of Chapter Leadership Development event, and won state level, while receiving a silver on the national level. The organization partners with the high school chapter to increase agriculture and leadership knowledge.

STEM is the acronym for Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics, and encompasses a vast array of subjects that fall into each of those terms. Occupations in STEM-related careers are some of the fastest growing and best paid of the 21st century. Our STEM Program offers: Design and Modeling, Robotics, and Automation and Robotics.

Lastly, the 7th grade students at MJHS continue to take full advantage of Learning.com, an initiative that provides digital curriculum and assessments, integrating technology and content into everyday instruction. In addition, Fundamentals of Computing (a high school credit course) was offered to our 8th grade students this year.
