

This report gives essential data to partners and stakeholders inside our local community. It is Manning Junior High School's desire to be one of the best schools in South Carolina. The School Improvement Council plays a functioning and positive role in supporting this idea.

During the 2020-2021 school year, Manning Junior High School has continued some of the same initiatives that have proven to be successful in years past. We have students meeting expectations for the Honor Roll and/or the National Jr. Beta Club.

The Original Six Foundation Afterschool Program is in it's 5th year at MJHS. It is a program where students work hard to improve their classroom learning through the completion of homework assignments and tutoring.

Students at MJHS are offered other opportunities to enrich their learning during afterschool hours due to daily Teacher Office hours. Each teacher provides at least one hour of academic assistance on a daily basis. During this time, students receive extra help, tutoring, and/or make up assignments.

The MJHS FFA chapter for 2020-2021 competed in the Conduct of Chapter Leadership Development event and won state level, resulting in a \$2,200 stipend. The organization partners with the high school chapter to increase agriculture and leadership knowledge.

With our partnership with Discovery Education, we provide a simple to use STEM learning platform that combines dynamic curated curriculum resources with ondemand teaching strategies, personalized to fit the needs of all teachers and students. This program content brings excitement and relevancy to topics taught so that all students have opportunities to unlock their true potential.

Lastly, the 7th grade students at MJHS continue to take full advantage of Learning.com, an initiative that provides digital curriculum and assessments, integrating technology and content into everyday instruction. Fundamentals of Computing and JROTC (high school credit courses) were offered to our 8th grade students again this year.
