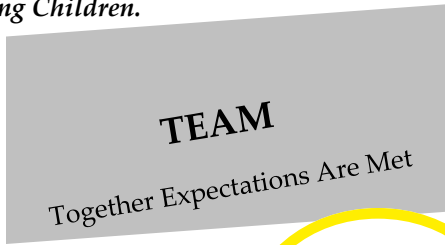


# MISSION STATEMENT

## MJHS School Goals for 2018-2019

1. By the end of the 2018-2019 school year, MJHS students scoring “ready” and “close” in ELA and Math will increase by 5% in each grade level on the state standardized assessment when compared to 2017-2018 state standardized assessment.
2. By the end of the 2018-2019 school year, MJHS students scoring “met” and “above” in Science and Social Studies will increase by 5% in each grade level on the state standardized assessment when compared to 2017-2018 state standardized assessment.
3. By the end of the 2018-2019 school year, MJHS students will increase 4 instructional reading levels as measured by the Next Step Reading Assessments.

Dear Parents,

The purpose of this report is to provide vital information to stakeholders within our community. It is Manning Junior High School's expectation to be the best school in South Carolina. The School Improvement Council continues to take an active and positive role in supporting this concept.

During the 2018-2019 school year, at Manning Junior High School, we have continued some of the same initiatives that have proven to be successful. Over half of the students are on the Honor Roll and/or the National Jr. Beta Club. The Original Six Foundation Afterschool Program is also in its 3rd year and is a program where students work hard to improve their reading and math skills. The students also participate in an Advisory Period each month where they work on various skills, such as: goal setting and test taking strategies. Seventh grade students receive in-class tutoring in all of their core classes while the eighth grade students receive additional help in Algebra 1 and English 1. The Future Farmers of America was established during the 2018-2019 school year. The organization partners with the high school chapter to learn about agriculture and leadership.

Our STEM Program focuses on the academic disciplines in: Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math. The STEM Program offers: Design and Modeling, Robotics, and Automation and Robotics. In addition to this, an introduction to Computer Science (*a high school course*) was offered to our middle school students this year.

Lastly, the students at MJHS continue to take full advantage of Rosetta Stone, an initiative that's in its 3rd year. Rosetta Stone is an interactive computer based program that develops language and literacy. Students at Manning Junior High School have an opportunity to choose from 2 different languages (*Spanish and French*).
