Instructional Program

The instructional program at Manning Early Childhood Center is based on the South Carolina College and Career Ready (SC-CCR) Standards, National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC) Standards, Child Development Program Guidelines, and the needs of students. Teachers use our state adopted standards, state issued textbooks, leveled books, Science and Math manipulatives, and a variety of other materials to make learning an engaging experience. The Literacy Program is based on a "Balanced Literacy" approach, which includes Foundational Skills, Shared Reading, Independent Reading, Read Alouds, and Writer's Workshop. Our district promotes best practices and teachers received intense training with implementing the Workshop Model with fidelity. All classes have interactive white boards and document cameras to facilitate learning. This has enabled us to make technology an integral part of the curriculum. Classes go weekly to the computer lab to practice keyboarding skills and to work on various programs. Our instructional program incorporates use of all the necessary tools to make our students successful in a 21st Century World.

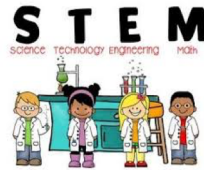
