School Renewal Strategic Plan Goals

In an effort of continuous Improvement, WGE conducted a comprehensive needs assessment and created goals and strategies to obtain these goals. The goals and strategies are included in the 5-year School Renewal Plan (2017-2022) and are listed below.

Student Achievement:

- Increase the percentage of students of scoring "meets" and "exceeds" categories as measured by the state assessment in ELA from 40.9% to 65.1%; in math from 40.9% to 65.9%; in Science from 70.7% to 80.7%; in Social Studies from 85.6% to 90.6%.
- Increase the percentage of students reading on grade level from 53% to 78% as measured by Fountas and Pinnell Assessments.

Teacher/Administrator Quality:

- Increase the percentage of teachers holding advanced degrees and/or National Board Certification from 68% to 78%.
- Cultivate the number of teachers who will participate in leadership roles within the school from 0 to 5 teachers.

School Climate:

 Increase the percentage of satisfied with home-school relations from 75% to 85% as measured by the State Department of Education Parent, Student, Teacher Survey.
