STAR

Star Reading is a leading computeradaptive assessment for grades I-12, it identifies skills and sub-skills students know, and which skills students are ready to work on next. Star reading maximizes instruction and practice with statespecific insights and resources to guide students on the optimal path to reading proficiency.

AR

The Accelerated Reader program is a computerized program that tests reading comprehension. Students select books on their reading level, read independently, and take an independent comprehension test on the computer. Each book is worth a certain number of points based on its length and reading level.
