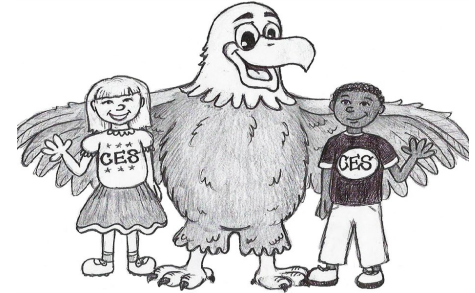
CES Beliefs:
