## Assessment

## STAR

Star Reading and Math are computeradaptive tests that continually adjust the difficulty of the child's test by choosing each test question based on the child's previous response. STAR Reading and Math help determine reading and math achievement levels in order to places students in the Accelerated Reader and Math programs. For every STAR assessment, a child receives a scaled score, which is based on the difficulty of the questions and the number of correct answers. Scaled scores are useful for comparing a child's performance over time and across grades.
