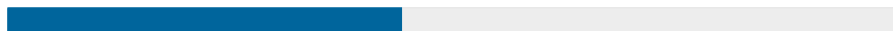
- Increase the percentage of students scoring at the meets or exceeds level in ELA and Math.

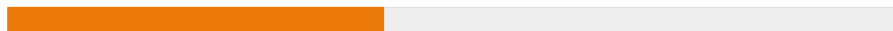
SC Ready English Language Arts and Mathematics

English Language Arts (Reading and Writing) - Percent Met or Exceeding

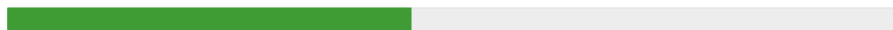

District 42.4% (4586 / 10823)

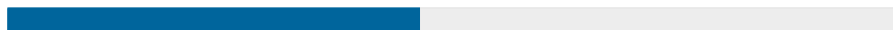


State 45.4% (159686 / 351481)

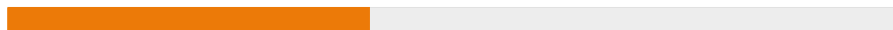


Mathematics - Percent Met or Exceeding

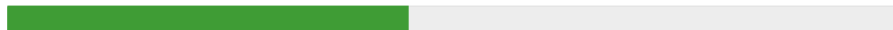
School 46.4% (70 / 151)
