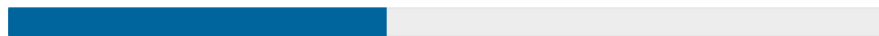

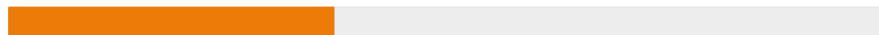
### SC Ready English Language Arts and Mathematics

English Language Arts (Reading and Writing) - Percent met and exceeding

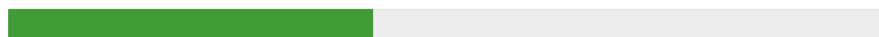

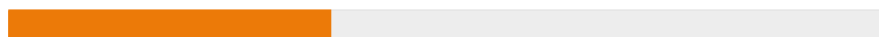


Mathematics - Percent met and exceeding

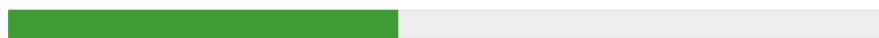
