

Academic SMART Goals 2021-2022

1st and 2nd Grade:

ELA– The percentage of students predicted to meet proficiency standards in Reading will increase from 40% to 50% as evidenced by the MAP Reading Assessment.

Math–The percentage of students predicted to meet proficiency standards in Math will increase from 30% to 40% as evidenced by the MAP Math Assessment.

3rd Grade-5th Grade:

ELA– The percentage of students predicted to meet proficiency standards in Reading will increase from 29% to 35% as evidenced by the MAP Reading Assessment.

Math–The percentage of students predicted to meet proficiency standards in Math will increase from 25% to 30% as evidenced by the MAP Math Assessment.

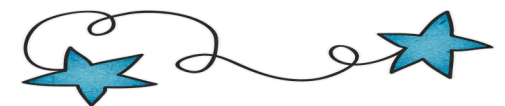
