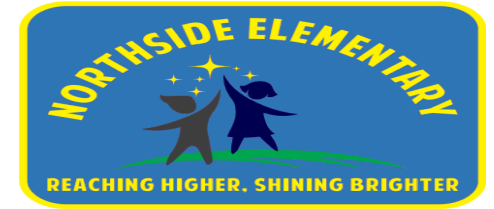

STAR Reading and Math Assessments are administered at the beginning, middle, and end of each school year. These assessments may also be given periodically to document growth in individual students. The data gleaned from these assessments allow teachers to identify areas of strength and weakness in their students and provide strategies for helping the students to continue to grow. Teachers consistently use formative and summative assessments in the classroom to plan for differentiated instruction based upon identified student need.

SC Ready in English Language Arts and Mathematics as well as SC PASS in 4th Grade Science were administered in the Spring of 2021. The South Carolina College - and Career-Ready Assessments (SC READY) program is a statewide assessment in English Language Arts (ELA) and mathematics administered to students in grades 3–8 as required by the Education Accountability Act.
