

2012-2013 HHS Honors and Accomplishments

- Five HHS seniors are currently Palmetto Fellows Scholarship winners.
- Every member of the HHS International Baccalaureate Class of 2012 qualified for South Carolina Education Lottery scholarships.
- Alex Morrison won first place in the Special Talent event at the SC Beta Club Convention.
- The HHS Beta Club collected 171 units of blood, impacting the lives of 510 patients, at its March 6, 2013 Red Cross Blood Drive. This was a record number of donations by a South Carolina high school in a Red Cross Blood Drive.
- The HHS Red Regime Marching Band finished second in the South Carolina Band Directors Association AAA Lower State Championships.
- The HHS Red Regime Marching Band finished ninth in the SCBDA AAA State Marching Championships.
- The HHS Jazz Messengers earned a Superior Rating at the SCBDA Jazz Band Festival.
- The HHS Winter Guard and Indoor Percussion won State Championships in their respective classes. These are the first state titles ever won by an HHS band program.
- The HHS Singers earned a Superior Rating at the SC Solo and Ensemble Competition.
- The HHS Singers, Red Fox Choir, and Freshman Choir received Excellent Ratings at the state-wide 2013 Choral Festival in Columbia.

Sarah and Alex also received Superior ratings at the state-wide National Association of Teachers of Singing and will advance to the Five-State Regional competition.

- The HHS Softball Team won the 2012 South Carolina AAA State Championship.
- The HHS Girls' Golf Team won the 2012 South Carolina AAA Lower State Championship.
- The HHS Volleyball Team won the 2012 Region 6-AAA Championship.
- Lindsey Brown and Drake Cassidy were named to the All-State Golf Team.
- The HHS Football Team won the 2012 South Carolina AAA State Championship.

The organization and authority of the School Improvement Council (SIC) are outlined in the 1977 Education Finance Act. Its responsibilities were expanded in 1984, 1993, and 1998 to include the information in this *Report to the Parents*. The purpose of this annual report, which is required by law, is to inform the community about the current status of education at Hartsville High School, as well as the plans for improvement.

The School Improvement Council is scheduled to meet monthly in conjunction with the Hartsville High School Academic Booster Club, and public participation is encouraged and welcomed. Any topic of interest or concern is appropriate and open to discussion, and participants are afforded the opportunity to ask questions of and offer input to the principal or his designee. Items that have been discussed in the past include the International Baccalaureate Programme, the physical facilities of the school, master schedule and curriculum issues, the School Report Card and AYP data, school safety and security, and incentives for academic achievement. The overarching goal of the School Improvement Council is to continue to improve the collaborative working relationship between the school, parents of our students, local business and industry, and the community. Red Fox Renaissance Continues

Partners for Unparalleled Local Scholastic Excellence Program (PULSE) Enhances Hartsville High School Curriculum Offerings

The Partners for Unparalleled Local Scholastic Excellence (PULSE) Program is a collaborative effort between the Hartsville High School International Baccalaureate (IB) Program, the Governor's School for Science and Mathematics (GSSM), and Coker College. The PULSE Program, generously funded by Sonoco Products Company, will offer eligible Hartsville area students, in addition to the IB Programme curriculum at Hartsville High School, the opportunity to take Accelerated Learning Opportunities (ALO) enhanced courses in science, math and foreign language at GSSM, as well as college-credit art, design, music, theater and dance courses at Coker College.

International Baccalaureate Programme Excels

Six HHS students were awarded the International Baccalaureate Diploma in June 2012. Hartsville High School students performed extremely well on IB exams, as 100% of our students earned scores of "4" or higher on 11 different IB assessments, including Math Studies SL for the fourth consecutive year. HHS IB students exceeded the international average scores in Math Studies SL, Music SL, and Music HL. The average SAT score of HHS IB Class of 2012 was 1668. This score exceeded by 185 points the average national SAT score for seniors, and was 241 points above the average South Carolina SAT score for seniors. All ten of the HHS Class of 2012 Top Ten are IB students, and 11 of 12 Graduation Marshals from the Class of 2013 are IB students. There is currently a record number of students (160) enrolled in IB and pre-IB courses at HHS.

Hartsville High School - Home of Champions

The Hartsville Lady Red Fox Softball Team defeated Daniel High School in a best two-of-three series to win the 2012 South Carolina AAA State Championship.

Kristen Sansbury won the 2012 South Carolina AAA State Championship in the shot put event. Kristen was also earned All-American honors at the New Balance Invitational Track and Field Championships.

The Hartsville Red Fox Football Team defeated Union County High School by a score of 65-27 at Williams-Brice Stadium in Columbia to win the 2012 South Carolina AAA State Championship. Their 15-0 record was the first unbeaten and untied football season in school history.

The Hartsville Red Fox Boys' Basketball Team defeated Eastside High School of Taylors by a score of 65-62 in overtime at the Colonial Life Arena in Columbia to win the 2012-13 South Carolina AAA State Championship. This was the second consecutive South Carolina AAA State Championship for the Red Foxes, who finished with a record of 28-1.
