Performance Goals

 - Continued to implement athletics and extra- curricular activities such as, boy's and girls' basketball, cheerleading, 4H Club, Nutrition Club and Jr. BETA for students and parents to participate in and generate school pride.
 - 100% of our parents attended parent-teacher conferences.
 - 78% of our teachers returned from the previous year.
 - Band won 2nd place at Region Band Competition in Myrtle Beach, SC; ranked "Excellent"
 - Five students earned placements at Solo and Ensemble at West Florence High School: <u>2</u> Superior, <u>2</u> Excellent, and <u>1</u> Good
