## Performance Goals

- The percentage of students scoring Met and Exemplary in ELA will increase to 17.1% as measured by SC Ready.
  - REMS met this goal in all grades except 3<sup>rd</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, and 7<sup>th</sup> (see table).
  - REMS met AYP/ESEA for 2015 with a 72.3 composite score.
- The percentage of students scoring Met and Exemplary in Science will increase to 50% as measured by SC Pass.
  - REMS met this goal in all grades except 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> (see table).
- The percentage of students scoring Met and Exemplary in Social Studies will increase to 33% as measured by PASS.
  - REMS met this goal in all grades (see table).
- The percentage of high quality teachers will increase to 100% as reported in our school report card.
  - REMS met this goal.
  - Maintained 100% high quality teachers.
  - Home of District Teacher of the Year 2012-13.
  - Home to the 2014-15 Darlington County School District's Outstanding First Year Teacher, Ms. Nicola Wynn
  - Increased the number of teachers with advanced degrees to 50.0%
  - Hired a Reading Coach to support high quality literacy instruction
- The percentage of parents and teachers satisfied with the learning environment will increase to 87.3% as measured by report card surveys.
  - 75% of surveyed students reported satisfaction with the learning environment.
  - 71.4% of surveyed students reported satisfaction with school-home relations.
  - 78.6% of surveyed students reported satisfaction with the physical and social environment.
  - Continued to implement athletics and extra- curricular activities such as running club, boy's and girls' basketball, cheerleading, and Jr. BETA for students and parents to participate in and generate school pride.
  - 100% of our parents attended parent-teacher conferences.
  - 72.5% of our teachers returned from the previous year.
