School Renewal Performance Goals

The percentage of students scoring met and exemplary in English/Language Arts will increase to 79 % or higher by 2018-2019 as measured by the South Carolina state assessment (PASS).

The percentage of students scoring met and exemplary in Mathematics will increase to 58.7% or higher by 2018-2019 as measured by the South Carolina state assessment (PASS).

The percentage of students scoring met and exemplary in Science will increase to 66.2% or higher by 2018-2019 as measured by the South Carolina state assessment (PASS).

The percentage of students scoring met and exemplary in Social Studies will increase to 72.5% or higher by 2018-2019 as measured by the South Carolina state assessment (PASS).

Parental and community involvement in our students' education will increase (through attending parent/teacher conferences, IEP meetings, parenting workshops, and other school events) to at least 5% participation by the 2018.
