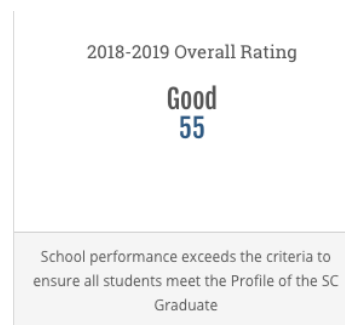

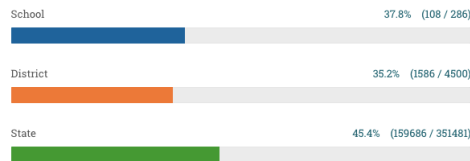

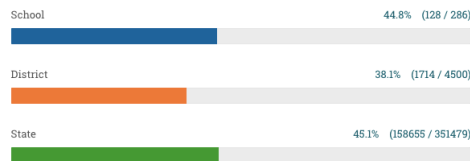

English Language Arts (Reading and Writing) - Percent Met or Exceeding

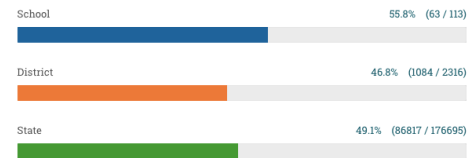


Mathematics - Percent Met or Exceeding

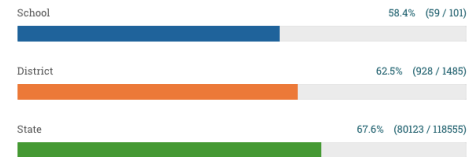


SCPASS Science and Social Studies
