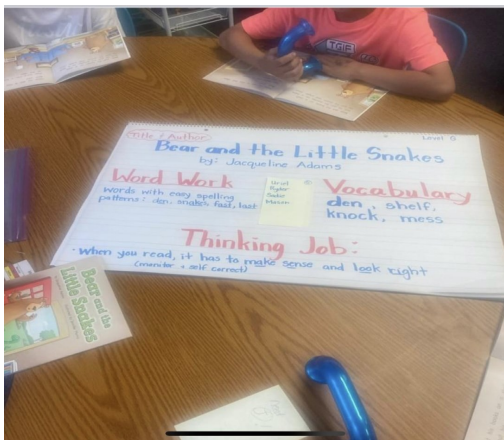


## Guided Reading

During the 2021-22 school year, we took a closer look at Guided Reading Implementation, Flexible Grouping, and Data Analysis. Teachers participated in weekly Collaborative Planning Meetings and Professional Development sessions to explore and refine our Guided Reading instructional implementation. Each component of Guided Reading was reviewed and modeled. Teachers were given ample time to explore the components by participating in collaborative dialogue. Guided Reading checklist were distributed and feedback given as teachers implemented components of Guided Reading.

To ensure effective communication between home and school, we met with parents during Pastries with the Principal to discuss the components of Grading Triangulation and the Articulation Process. To support our Guided Reading efforts it is important for us to share information with parents and discuss how we will analyze data on-going and provide daily instruction that will meet the specific needs of all learners at Hammond Hill Elementary School.



## Goal

The goal of our School Improvement Council is to provide ways to improve our instructional practices in reading and mathematics. SIC in collaboration with the school's administration and PTO engaged in meaningful dialogue around Guided Reading Implementation, Data Analysis and Flexible Grouping to build teachers' capacity and increase students' overall academic performance as measured by MAP, SCReady and teacher created assessments.
