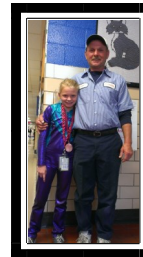
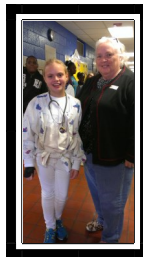
### Student Achievement
