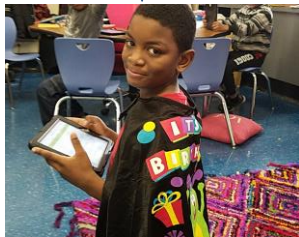


### Our Vision

## School Renewal Plan Goals

### ELA

The percentage of students meeting or exceeding (score level 3 or higher on SC Ready/D or higher on EOC) the English/Language Arts expectations will increase to at least 70% as measured by the standardized assessment administered by the State of South Carolina or MAP, which is administered by Darlington County School District.

The percentage of students meeting or exceeding (score level 2 or higher on SC Ready/C or higher on EOC) the English/Language Arts expectations will increase to at least 90% as measured by the standardized assessment administered by the State of South Carolina or MAP, which is administered by Darlington County School District.

### Math

As established by the State of South Carolina, by 2035:

The percentage of students meeting or exceeding (score level 3 or higher on SC Ready/D or higher on EOC) the Mathematics expectations will increase to at least 70% as measured by the standardized assessment administered by the State of South Carolina or MAP, which is administered by Darlington County School District.

The percentage of students meeting or exceeding (score level 2 or higher on SC Ready/C or higher on EOC) the Mathematics expectations will increase to at least 90% as measured by the standardized assessment administered by the State of South Carolina or MAP, which is administered by Darlington County School District.

### Positive and Effective Learning Environment

As established by the State of South Carolina, by 2035: The percentage of English learner students meeting proficiency (score of 4.4) growth targets will increase to at least 70% as defined by the ACCESS for ELLs 2.0 summative assessment.

As established by the State of South Carolina, by 2035: The percentage of students reported to be engaged at the level of "committed" will be at least 90% in all 3 domains (Behavioral, Cognitive, and Emotional).
