School Renewal Plan Goals

Student Achievement

Millbrook Elementary will increase our percentage of students scoring Meets or Exceeds in ELA from 56.6% to 71.16% based on SC Ready State Assessment. In Math we will increase our Meets and Exceeds from 53.9% to 66.56% measured by SC Ready State Assessment.

Teacher/Administrator Quality and Student Progress

Millbrook Elementary will enhance teacher and administrator effectiveness through targeted professional development and collaborative leadership, with the aim of increasing student growth. Specifically, the goal is to raise the overall student progress percentage from 32.4% to 38.4% as measured by the SC State Report Card.

School Climate

Millbrook Elementary will increase our overall perception of school climate from 8.08 to 9.08 as measured by SC State Climate Survey.

Multilingual Learner Progress

Millbrook Elementary will increase the percentage of students who Met Progress toward their proficiency target from 82.9 to 87.9 as measured by ACCESS Testing.

Preparing for Success

Millbrook Elementary will increase our Science Mean Score from 53.3 to 58.3 as measured by SC State Testing.

Review of 2024-2025 School Renewal Goals Accomplished: **Curriculum**

- MAP data was used to analyze students' needs and plan instruction.
- We refined our Multi-Tier System of Support
- Implemented new interventions based on the Science of Reading

- Teachers participated in staff development with a focus on Math and LETRS.

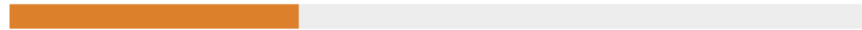

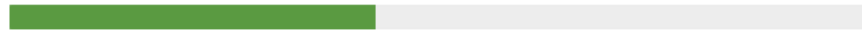
