

## Review of 2021-2022 School Renewal Goals Accomplished: Curriculum

- \*MAP data was used to analyze students' needs and plan instruction.
- \*System 44 and Read 180 instruction was implemented through the reading initiative and SRI score analysis.
- \*Two reading intervention teachers were funded through Title 1 funds.
- \*Multiple grants (SRNS and Donor's Choose) were received and used to enhance Science and Math instruction.
- \*Teachers participated in staff development with a focus on the writing workshop.
- \*Provided teachers with relevant professional reading opportunities.
- \*Fountas and Pinnell testing data was used to guide reading instruction.
- \*One Reading Coach was funded by the Read to Succeed program.
