- By June 2026, students in K-5 will show a decrease of 3% from discipline referrals decreasing from a baseline of 496 down to 481.

Progress and Outcomes

As of April 2026, we met our first goal of “By June 2026, students in K-5 will show growth in achievement of 3% from the 55th percentile to the 58th percentile on Map Reading from Fall to Spring.” Spring MAP results showed a growth of 10 percentile points from 55% in the Fall of 2025 to 65% in the Spring of 2026.

As of April 2026, we met our second goal of “By June 2026, students in K-5 will show growth in achievement of 3% from the 54th percentile to the 57th percentile on Map Math from Fall to Spring.” Spring MAP results showed a growth of 5 percentile points from Fall of 2025 54% to 59% in the Spring of 2026.

As of April 2026, we are on track to meet our third goal of “By June 2026, students in K-5 will show a decrease of 3% from discipline referrals decreasing from a baseline of 496 down to 481.

Next Steps

In the 2026-2027 school year, we anticipate the addition of 300 students from a neighboring school and look forward to seeing continued growth in reading, math, and behavior. There will be a focus of creating a welcoming environment for staff, students and families, with a focus on communication, family involvement, and expectations to maintain and build on the positive culture of Summerville Elementary School.
