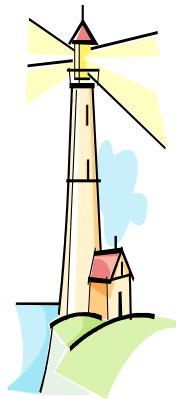
Student Leadership Roles
