Our History

Newington Elementary School opened its doors on Valentine's Day in 1977. The school is built on land that was originally part of a 3,000 acre grant by the King of England. Newington Elementary currently serves over 800 students in four-year-old kindergarten through fifth grade.

Our School Today

- Currently, 800 students are enrolled in 4K-5th grades.
- Average daily attendance for the 2019 school year was 92.6%.
- In 2019, 83.1% of our 5th grade parents indicated satisfaction with the learning environment of the school, 80.5% were satisfied with the social and physical environment, and 74.6% were satisfied with home-school relations.
- 50.9% of the teachers at NES have advanced degrees.
