-Currently, 717 students are enrolled in 4 K - 5 th grades ( 555 students are in the school based model and 162 are in the virtual academy). -Average daily attendance for the 2020 school year was $96 \%$. -In 2019, 83.1\% of our 5th grade parents indicated satisfaction with the learning environment of the school. $80.5 \%$ were satisfied with the social and physical environment, and $74.6 \%$ were satisfied with home-school relations. $-\ln 2020,56.9$ of the teachers at NES have advanced degrees.
