Our School Today

- Currently, 920 students are enrolled in 4K-5th grades.
- Average daily attendance for the 2017 school year was 94.9%.
- In 2017, 97.4% of our 5th grade parents indicated satisfaction with the learning environment of the school, 91.9% were satisfied with the social and physical environment, and 72.2% were satisfied with homeschool relations.
- 49.1% of the teachers at NES have advanced degrees.
