Our Instructional Program

The teachers of North Aiken Elementary deliver high quality instruction daily. Our students received instruction based on South Carolina College and Career Ready Standards. They were assessed using the Fountas and Pinnell Benchmark Assessment, district-created benchmark assessments, the Reading and Math Inventory, and teacher-created assessments to monitor teaching and learning. The students of North Aiken Elementary were exposed to extended learning opportunities in writing, reading, and math in our before and after school programs. Technology based programs to enhance and enrich math and reading skills were also available before, during, and after school. The teachers participated in professional development opportunities including the use of LLI Intervention System, implementation of the Reader's and Writer's Workshop, and the utilization of Aiken County Public School's curriculum maps to create a learning environment that fosters academic achievement.

Title I Funds

The 2016 – 2017 Title I funds were used to employ a Behavior Modification Room aide, a parenting aide, and three half-time academic interventionists. In addition, instructional resources were purchased to support our academic program. These resources included additional computers in the classrooms for student use.
