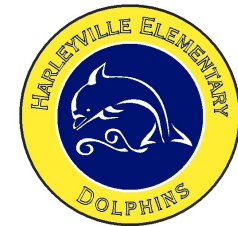

## Harleyville Elementary

### Instructional Goals

- ⇒ At least 88% of third graders will score approaches, meets, or exceeds on ELA on SC Ready by 2021.
- ⇒ At least 65% of fourth graders will score approaches, meets, or exceeds on ELA on SC Ready by 2021.
- ⇒ At least 72% of fifth graders will score approaches, meets, or exceeds on ELA on SC Ready by 2021.
- ⇒ At least 90% of third graders will score approaches, meets, or exceeds on math on SC Ready by 2021.
- ⇒ At least 75% of fourth graders will score approaches, meets, or exceeds on math on SC Ready by 2021.
- ⇒ At least 82% of fifth graders will score approaches, meets, or exceeds on math on SC Ready by 2021.
- ⇒ At least 59% of fourth graders will score met or exceeding on science on SCPASS by 2021.

- ◆ Providing ongoing relevant and quality professional development for staff.
- ◆ Involving all stakeholders in all aspects of the SIC and Title One Committee.
